

This indenture made this ninth day of December One thousand eight hundred and sixteen Between Henry Cobbitt of New Kent County of the one part and Bailey Fox of King William County of the other part witnesseth that the said Henry Cobbitt for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars current money to him in hand paid by the said Bailey Fox before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge and of the same and every part thereof do acquit release and discharge the said Bailey Fox his heirs ^{from} by these presents have granted bargained and sold to all the land that was given to me by Henry Cobbitt King William County which was allotted off or draw'd at the June Court last containing forty eight and two thirds acres more or less, and bounded by the Lands of Mr George Slaughter and Nathan Fox, and all the buildings trees &c to the said tract of Land belonging or in any wise appertaining and the mansion and messuage, demesne, rents issues and profits thereof and every part thereof, as the right little claim entiteth and demandeth valuation of him the said Fox of me and to him to have and to hold the aforesaid land all and singular the premises with the appurtenances unto the said Bailey Fox to the only person we and he left of him the said Fox his heirs & forever And the said Henry Cobbitt for himself and with the said Bailey Fox his heirs to that he the said Henry Cobbitt for himself and his heirs discharge of and from all other Estates

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This Indenture made this 20 day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eleven between Joseph B. Gatewood of Jefferson County and State of Virginia Kentucky of the one part and Lucy Gafford of the County of King William and State of Virginia of the other part. Whereas John Gatewood late of the State of Kentucky did by his last will and testament devise a certain tract of Land lying in the aforesaid County of King William and State of Virginia along with other real and personal estate to be divided among twelve of his children, a reference to said will and will more fully appear Whereas the said Joseph B. Gatewood is entitled to one twelfth part of the said undivided tract or parcel of land lying as aforesaid. Now this Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of seventy dollars in hand paid by the said Lucy Gafford unto the said Joseph B. Gatewood, which sum is hereby acknowledged by the said Joseph B. Gatewood having granted bargained and sold and do by these presents grant to
