one thousand eight hundred and six. Between Henry Smith of the County
and city of Richmond and Sarah his wife of the one part are James
Slaughter of the County of King William and parish of St. John of the other
it is witnesseth that the said Henry Smith and Sarah his wife for a sum
enumeration of sum of one hundred and sixty pounds current money to the
one of them in hand paid by the said James Slaughter the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged and sheweth and of every part thereof doth acquit
and discharge the said James Smith his heirs executors and administrators
of granted bargains and sales aforesaid released and confirmed as by these
wents do grant bargain and sell also release and confirm unto the said
James Slaughter his heirs and assigns forever a tract piece or parcel of land
bearing fifty one acres and half more or less beginning at a corner red oak
between Henry Slaughter and the said land on the road leading to Bahadur
mill thence to a corner red oak between Dandridge & Jasonne and the said
Smith from thence along to a corner stump between the said Smith and
the said Jasonne and Reuben B. Lipcomb from thence across to a line
between the said Lipcomb and the said Smith from thence to a corner white
oak between the said Henry Slaughter and the said Smith and the said Reuben
B. Lipcomb from thence along between the said Slaughter and Smith to the
beginning place on the road together with all houses trees woods ways water
water courses profits commodities hereditaments and appurtenances belonging
to the said plantation tract or parcel of land belonging to me any and
appertaining To have and to hold the said land and all and singular the
appurtenances before mentioned unto the said James Slaughter his
heirs executors and administrators for ever against the said Smith him his
affees and all other persons whatsoever shall and will answer

Laws Gentlemen Justices of the County of King William Building wherein
Henry Smith and Sally his wife have by their indenture of bargain and
sealing date the 30th day of January 1806 sold and conveyed unto James Slaughter
one certain tract of land or part of land containing by estimation fifty one acres being
some more or less lying and being in the County of King William and whereas
the said Sally cannot conveniently travel to our county court of King William
to make acknowledgment of the said conveyance therefore we do give unto you or any
two or more of you power to examine her purity and take her acknowledgement
concerning the conveyance aforesaid contained in the said Indenture which is hereto
annexed and we command you that you personally go to the said Sally and examine
her purity and a part from the said Henry Smith her husband concerning her
executing the said Indenture and take her acknowledgement thereupon and when
you have examined her as aforesaid and received her acknowledgement that you
sufficiently and plainly certify to us therof in our said court annexed to the
said King William Robert Pollard clerk of our said Court the 1st day of May
on the 4th Year of our foundation
