Evans Gentlemen Justices of the County of King William greeting whereas
Henry Smith and Sally his wife have by their indenture of bargain and sale
bearing date the 30th day of January 1806 sold and conveyed unto James Haughton
one certain tract or parcel of land containing by estimation fifty one acres be it
said more or less lying and being in the County of King William upon whereas
the said Sally cannot conveniently travel to our county court of King William
to make acknowledgment of the said conveyance therefore we do give unto you, or any
two or more of you power to examine her privately and take her acknowledgments
concerning the conveyance aforesaid contained in the said Indenture which is hereto
annexed and we command you that you personally go to the said Sally and examine
her privately and apart from the said Henry Smith her husband concerning her
execution of the said Indenture and take her acknowledgment thereupon and when
