

This Indenture made this 10 day of Octob: 1814, between Herbert A. Claiborne of the one part, and Wm P. Claiborne of the other part, all of the County of Henry William & Parish of St. John, Mizen both that the said Herbert A. Claiborne in consideration of the sum of five dollars to him this day in hand paid by the said Wm P. Claiborne, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath this day bargained & sold, and by these presents doth hereby bargain & sell unto the said Wm P. Claiborne, his heirs and assigns, a certain tract or parcel of land, lying & being in the County & Parish aforesaid, the meale and boundaries whereof are as follows to wit. From the point where Knight's Swamp intersects the the line, which divides the lands of Wm Langhorne from Wm D. Strawn, thence down the S. Swamp between me & the S. Strawn, until it discharges itself into Jacks creek, up the meanderings of the S. Creek to the line which divides the S. Land from the land of Wm Langhorne, from thence along the S. line to the beginning, containing One hundred acres more or less with all & singular the tenements hereditaments & appurtenances thereto belonging, or in any wise appertaining. To have and to hold the said tract of land with all & singular and remainments, reversion & reversionary parts & other profits, to the only use and behoof of him the S. Wm P. Claiborne, his heirs & assigns forever. In testimony whereof he the said Herbert A. Claiborne hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and year first above written.
