

This Indenture made the 24<sup>th</sup> day of  
thousand eight hundred and eighty one between  
of the one part, and Amistead Robins of the other part  
both of the Parish of Saint John's County of King William  
Virginia that the said James H. Dugar for and in  
consideration of the sum of one thousand two hundred  
Dollars to him in hand paid or secured to be paid  
by the said Amistead Robins, at or before the making  
and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby  
acknowledged, he the said James H. Dugar hath bargained  
and sold, and by these presents doth grant bargain and  
sell unto the said Amistead Robins his heirs and assigns  
one certain lot, piece or parcel of land lying, situate and  
being in the Parish and County aforesaid containing by the  
survey one hundred and fifty acres be the same more  
or less, and bounded by the main road leading from  
King William County to West Point, by the lands of  
Madison, Mrs. Molly Powers those whereof John Powers  
lately died seized and possessed, and the lands which  
said Robins lately purchased of Mrs. Margaret Powers  
Sixty four acres of which said tract or parcel of land  
was bequeathed to the said James H. Dugar by the will  
of his father James Dugar late of the said County dead  
and the balance of eighty six acres the said James H.  
Dugar purchased of Simon Guthow as per deed  
records in the Court of said County, reference  
thereto had, will more fully appear, together  
all and singular the emoluments, hereditaments and  
appurtenances thereto belonging or attached, and the rents,  
issues and reversions, remainders and contingencies  
profits thereof and of every part and parcel thereof  
To have and to hold the said tract, piece or parcel  
land together with all and singular the  
hereditaments and appurtenances

 The title of the aforesaid tract passed or parcel of land to  
 the said Robins and his heirs and assigns against the  
 claim and demands of him the said James M. Dugan  
 his executors or administrators or either of them, and against  
 the lawful claim or demand of all and every person or persons  
 whatsoever shall and will warrant and prove defend by these  
 presents - In testimony whereof the said James M. Dugan  
 hath hereunto set his hand and seal the day and year  
 herein written.
