This Indenture made this 28th day of August one thousand eight hundred and
Between James Ellitt of the County of King William of the one part and Daniel
Ellitt of the same County of the other parts Whereas, Ellitt late of the County
King William died seized and possessed of a certain tract or parcel of land situated
and being in the said County of King William containing by estimation three
hundred Acres more or less and by his last Will and Testament devised the same
to his wife Elizabeth Ellitt for and during her natural life and at her death
to be equally divided between his four sons viz: James, Daniel, Benjamin and
William Ellitt. Now this Indenture Witnesseth that the said James Ellitt
for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and ten pounds lawful money of
Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Daniel the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged by the said James hath given granted bargained and sold and
by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell unto the said Daniel all right
title interest claim and demand which he the said James now hath or hereafter
may have to the said tract or parcel of land and premises to have and to hold
all the right title interest claim and demand whatever of him the said James
in and to the said tract or parcel of land and premises with its appurtenances
unto the said Daniel Ellitt his heirs and assigns forever And the said James
Ellitt for himself his heirs Executors and administrators the before mentioned
granted premises unto the said Daniel Ellitt his heirs and assigns forever
warrant and by these presents forever defend against the claim and demand
of him the said James Ellitt his heirs Executors and administrators and
and every other person or persons whatsoever. In witness whereof the said James
