

This 21st of the 1st month of August 1813
 between eight hundred and twelve, between John Butler of the county
 of the one part and John Cardwell of the same county of the second part
 that the said John Butler for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred
 four cents to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge
 granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, release
 confirm unto him the said John Cardwell twenty acres of Land part of the
 which he the said John Butler now has, on which the Spring that is used by
 Butler, is included and a half of an acre of land around the Spring reserved for
 which is clipped of from a white Oak near the side of the wet land of Mahigon
 to a Pine above the Spring, thence to a small pine, thence to another small pine
 from thence to the white Oak and a path reserved to the said Spring, the said
 acres bounded as follows, beginning at the mouth of Richard Cochran Spring
 emptying into Mahigon Swamp, and running up the said Mahigon swamp as at
 under 100 Poles to Thomas Floyds corner, thence with said Floyds land at 71st 1/2
 Poles to a small wood lot, situate upon the corner with the neck of said Butlers land, thence
 by a new line of 13 1/2 Poles to a small lot newly made corner with said Butlers
 in Richard Cochran line thence with said Cochran line at 71st 1/2 to 13 Poles to a
 at the side of a gully, thence down that Gully and Richard Cochran Spring
 as they measure 30 Poles to the beginning, together with all and singular the premises
 and promises hereby conveyed and all and every part and parcel thereof unto
 the said John Cardwell his heirs and assigns for ever in fee absolute and uncondi-
 -ed fee simple, to have and to hold unto the said John Cardwell his heirs and assigns
 And the said John Butler for himself his heirs, executors and assigns, do further covenant
 agree to and with the said John Cardwell his heirs and assigns, that he the said John
 Butler his heirs, executors and assigns doth and do will the said land and premises hereby conveyed, and
 and every part and parcel thereof unto him the said John Cardwell his heirs and assigns
 and assigns will by these presents warrant and for ever defend, against the right, title
 and demand of all and every person and persons whatsoever. In testimony whereof
