

This Indenture made this third day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eight between William Sytell of the one part and John Spiller of the other part of King William County in consideration of the just and full sum of one hundred and twelve pounds sterling and eight pence to him in hand paid on or before the sealing here presents the receipt whereof the said Sytell doth hereby acknowledge and staves doth acquit and discharge the said Spiller both granted and agreed are by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said William Spiller and his assigns eighty nine and two thirds acres of land to have long the lot (No. 1) of a tract or parcel of land held in fee simple the property of the estate of William Sytell deceased and divided among the legatees of the same Sytell of whom the said William was one lying in the county of King William one parish of St. David adjoining the land of Thomas Colchette together with all and singular the appurtenances to the said lot or parcel of land belonging or in any wise appertaining to the same In witness whereof I have hereunto set our hands this ninth day of March in the year above written

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~~This Indenture~~ made this 27<sup>th</sup> day of April One thousand eight hundred and seven between John Reynolds of the one part and William Quaster of the other both of the County of King William Weymouth that the said John Reynolds for in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said William Quaster at or before the execution and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge to the said John Reynolds grants and conveys and confirms unto the said William Quaster his heirs and assigns one certain tract piece or parcel of land with all and singular its appurtenances containing by estimation twenty five acres be the same more or less lying in the County of King William and parish of St. David and is a part of the tract of land wherein the said John now resides and on which the said William has resided for two years past and at present resides thereunto to have and to hold the said tract piece or parcel of land together with all and singular other the premises and appurtenances thereto belonging unto him the said William Quaster

and affirms further that he has executed and administered warrant and forever defend the right  
to the said land and premises against the claim or demand of all and every person or persons

one thousand eight hundred and six. Between Henry Smith of the County  
and city of Richmond and Sarah his wife of the one part are James  
Slaughter of the County of King William and parish of St. John of the other  
it is witnesseth that the said Henry Smith and Sarah his wife for a sum  
enumeration of sum of one hundred and sixty pounds current money to the  
one of them in hand paid by the said James Slaughter the receipt whereof  
is hereby acknowledged and sheweth and of every part thereof doth acquit  
and discharge the said James Smith his heirs executors and administrators  
of granted bargains and sales aforesaid released and confirmed as by these  
wents do grant bargain and sell also release and confirm unto the said  
James Slaughter his heirs and assigns forever a tract piece or parcel of land  
bearing fifty one acres and half more or less beginning at a corner red oak  
between Henry Slaughter and the said land on the road leading to Bahadur  
mill thence to a corner red oak between Dandridge & Jasonne and the said  
Smith from thence along to a corner stump between the said Smith and  
the said Jasonne and Reuben B. Lipcomb from thence across to a line  
between the said Lipcomb and the said Smith from thence to a corner white  
oak between the said Henry Slaughter and the said Smith and the said Reuben  
B. Lipcomb from thence along between the said Slaughter and Smith to the  
beginning place on the road together with all houses trees woods ways water  
water courses profits commodities hereditaments and appurtenances belonging  
to the said plantation tract or parcel of land belonging to me any and  
appertaining To have and to hold the said land and all and singular the  
appurtenances before mentioned unto the said James Slaughter his  
heirs executors and administrators for ever against the said Smith him his  
affees and all other persons whatsoever shall and will answer  
for and defend by these presents. In witness whereof the said Henry
