Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia and to his successors in the sum of two thousand five hundred dollars to the payment whereof well and truly to be made we bind ourselves our heirs executors and administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents Witness our hands and seals the 25<sup>th</sup> day of June 1806

The conditions of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound John Roane is constituted and appointed Sheriff of the County of King William by commission from the Governor under the seal of the Commonwealth dated the 18<sup>th</sup> day of June 1806 if therefore the said John Roane shall well and truly collect all taxes and accounts for and pay the same in such manner as is by law directed and aft. all fines forfeitures and amercements accruing or becoming due to the Commonwealth in the said County and shall duly account for and pay the same to the Treasurer of the Commonwealth for the time being and for the use of the Commonwealth in like manner as is or shall be directed in case of public taxes shall in all things truly and faithfully execute the said office of Sheriff during his continuance therein then the above obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force and virtue

sums of money and tobacco by him received by virtue of any such process to the person or persons  
to whom the same are due his or their executors administrators or assigns and in all other  
things shall truly and faithfully execute and perform the said office of sheriff during
