Know all men by these presents that I John Wooddy of the County of King William have for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred and sixty nine dollars and five cents for which William L. Abraham and Susanna Abraham have become bound this day as security for me, bargained sold and delivered unto them the said William L. Abraham and Susanna Abraham, the following property to wit, Town, Gate, allvians, Ben Rhoda and Charles. And I do by these presents warrant and defend the title to said property, to wit, Town, Gate, allvians, Benjamin, Rhoda and Charles unto them the said William L. Abraham and Susanna Abraham, against myself, my heirs executors and administrators, and against the claim or claims of all and every person or persons whatsoever. But it is to be understood that upon my discharging the debts for which the above William L. Abraham and Susanna Abraham have become bound for me, as above stated, that the said property is to be restituted to me, or such of it as may be in existence at that time such discharge shall be made. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this fourth day of March 1817.
