 Randall Tom and Charlotte with her future increase hereon before mentioned
 unto the said Bernard Depreant and Wm Gregory their heirs Executors and
 assigns (notwithstanding that the said Bernard Depreant and Wm Gregory
 a surety Judgment being entered up on any Court within this Commonwealth
 P. Chamberlayne Sheriff as aforesaid for damages or Costs in consequence
 of the negroes aforesaid to satisfy the said Samuel Garlick's debts mentioned
 above referred to) after advertising the time and place of the sale of the before
 bargained and sold ten days at the public Court house of the County, for
 the highest bidder for the best price that may be obtained and out
 sale in the first place to pay and satisfy such reasonable charges as
 shall be incurred in the said sale and then to pay and satisfy such debts or judgments as may be entered up against
 the Sheriff as aforesaid together with all the legal costs and charges, and the
 money arising from such sale as aforesaid to the use of the said Bernard
 Depreant or to such person or persons as he by writing under his hand shall
 direct in writing to such person or persons as would be then entitled by
