The Commonwealth of Virginia to John Fox and John Toliford Gentlemen from King William County bearing witness whereas John Taylor and Lucy his wife have by their written indenture of Bargain and sale bearing date the 21<sup>st</sup> day of November 1811 sold and conveyed unto Edmund Taylor a certain tract or parcel of land containing One thousand acres and appurtenances lying in the county of King William And whereas the said Lucy Taylor cannot conveniently travel to the Court of the said county of King William to make acknowledgement of the said Indenture Therefore we do give unto you or any two or more officers power to receive the acknowledgement which the said Lucy Taylor shall be willing to make of the conveyance aforesaid contained in the said Indenture which is annexed And we do therefore command you that you do personally go to the said Lucy Taylor and receive her acknowledgement of the same in writing her privately and apart from her said husband when she doth the same freely & voluntarily without his persuasions or threats and when she be willing that the same should be recorded in the county Court of King William aforesaid and when you have received her acknowledgement and examined her aforesaid that you distinctly certify us thereof in our Court under your seals under there this 21<sup>st</sup> day of January 1811 in the 35<sup>th</sup> year of our foundation -
