The Commonwealth of Virginia to John Fox and John Taliaferro Gentlemen
King William County Creating Whereas John Taylor and Lucy his wife have by their
indenture of bargain and sale bearing date the 11th day of November, 1811, sold and conveyed
into Edmund Taylor a certain tract or parcel of land containing One thousand acres
and appurtenances lying in the county of King William. And whereas the said Lucy
cannot conveniently travel to the Court of the said county of King William to make
acknowledgment of the said Indenture. Therefore we do give unto you, or any two or more of you,
power to receive the acknowledgment which the said Lucy Taylor shall be willing to make
of the conveyance aforesaid contained in the said Indenture which is annexed And we do
therefore command you that you do personally go to the said Lucy Taylor and receive her ac-
knowledgment of the same and examine her privately and apart from her said husband, whether
she doth the same freely & voluntarily without his persuasions or threats, and when
she be willing that the same should be recorded in the county Court of King William
aforesaid; and when you have received her acknowledgment and examined her as aforesaid
that you distinctly & fully certify us thereof in our Court under your seals, sending
there the said Witness Robert Pollard Clerk of our said Court then 11th day of December
1811, in the 35th year of our said foundation.
