This Indenture made this 20 day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eleven between Joseph B. Gatewood of Jefferson County and State of Virginia Kentucky of the one part and Lucy Gafford of the County of King William and State of Virginia of the other part. Whereas John Gatewood late of the State of Kentucky did by his last will and testament devise a certain tract of Land lying in the aforesaid County of King William and State of Virginia along with other real and personal estate to be divided among twelve of his children, a reference to said will and will more fully appear Whereas the said Joseph B. Gatewood is entitled to one twelfth part of the said undivided tract or parcel of land lying as aforesaid. Now this Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of seventy dollars in hand paid by the said Lucy Gafford unto the said Joseph B. Gatewood, which sum is hereby acknowledged by the said Joseph B. Gatewood having granted bargained and sold and do by these presents grant to

one and one half acre or parcel of Land lying in the County of King William  
in the State of Virginia, being one twentieth thereof written above the  
time or parcel of land contains by estimation Two hundred and eighty  
acres be the same more or less, it is the land called John Patterson's  
Land and to hold the said one twentieth of the said undivided tract of  
or parcel of land hereby conveyed unto the said Lucy Loftwick her heirs  
spouse forever, in free absolute and unconditional fee Simple to her own  
proper use and behoof, and the said Joseph B. Gatewood for himself his heirs  
and assigns further covenant to agree to and with the P. Lucy Loftwick his  
the said Joseph B. Gatewood his heirs &c the said land and premises hereby  
convey'd One twentieth part thereof unto the said Lucy Loftwick her heirs  
will by these presents forever warrant and defend against the claim  
and demand of all and every person and persons whatsoever - In testa-  
mony whereof the said Joseph B. Gatewood do hereunto set his hand &  
affix his seal the day and date of this instant,
