This Indenture made the eleventh day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and five between Samuel Bartok of the County of King William in the State of Virginia of the one part and Beverly Robinson of the same County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Samuel for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar of lawful money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Beverly the receipt whereof the said Samuel doth hereby acknowledge and for the further consideration of securing to the said Beverly the sum of twenty one pounds twelve shillings and ten pence three farthings of lawful money of Virginia he the said Samuel hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Beverly one bay mare named Vicki with her future increase to have and to hold the said mare with her future increase unto the said Beverly his heirs executors and administrators forever provided nevertheless and the true intent and meaning hereof is any thing herein contained to the contrary notwithstanding that if the said Samuel his heirs executors or administrators do and shall when required or demanded pay to the said Beverly his heirs executors and assigns the said sum of twenty one pounds twelve shillings and ten pence three farthings with Interest from the date of these presents together with the costs of recording and carrying this Indenture into execution then this Indenture and every thing herein contained shall cease determine and be void and the said Beverly for himself his heirs executors and assigns doth hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Samuel his heirs executors and administrators that the said Samuel his heirs executors and administrators shall not nor may have hold occupy possess and use the said Mare and her future increase to take and receive the service and profits arising
