This Indenture made this 11th of Dec^r 1811. between Montilgen Dugan
one part & William Gatewood of the other, each of the county of King William
Sheweth that the said Montilgen being anxious to provide a support for his
wife Sally provided she may at any time desire to live separated from him, for
the good and lawful considerations hereunto moving & especially for the consideration
of one dollar in hand paid by the said Gatewood, hath this day bargained and
sold by these presents doth hereby bargain sell and confirm to the said Gatewood
certain property to wit: one slave named Moses, one black Horse & Cogg, four
eight Hogs one Bed & Furniture, To have and to hold the said property to him
his heirs and assigns forever in trust nevertheless in the following manner for the
purpose to wit: that if the said Sally should decide on living separat and
from the said Montilgen & not tell then the said Gatewood shall take the
property in his possession and apply it or the profits thereof as may seem
proper in his discretion to the yearly support and maintenance of the said
Sally during her natural life and after her death if any should be left to divide
between the children of the said Sally which she has or may have by
the said Montilgen in equal portions. And the said Montilgen warrants & confirms
to the said property to him the said Gatewood free from the claim or claim
of himself and all persons whatsoever. And the said Gatewood covenants & binds himself
truly and faithfully to perform the trusts reposed in him by these presents
in witness whereof we have hereunto set our hand & affixed our seal
and our above mentioned in the presence of
