

This Indenture made this fourth day of August in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and twelve between Nathaniel Hillyard of the county of King William,  
and John Lumpkin of the same County of the other part, Wilmepseth, that the said Nathaniel  
Hillyard for and in consideration of the sum of One thousand and thirty four pounds current  
due to John Lumpkin to him in hand paid the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge, have granted bargained  
and sold to John Lumpkin the land by this his seal do grant, bargain sell, release and confirm unto the said John  
Lumpkin the same land plantation wherein to the said Nathaniel Hillyard now resides, containing  
recently Acre Four hundred and seventy acres bounded as follows, Count Beginning at a  
Oak on the north side of the rocky Mill Road corner with Roderick Starling's disme plot  
and running with that lane at N E 169 Poles to a small Sycamore pointer on the side of a  
Rattle and String line, corner with George P. Tracy's forty acre in presence of the said  
Thence S 15° E 278 Poles to a young Poplar in a Clash corner with Corryarm Hillyard  
in said Tracy's line, thence S 13° W 367 Poles to two red Cedars corner with said Hillyard in a  
on the Red mill road, thence up the said Road as it winds 360 Poles to the beginning  
together with all and singular the franchises appurtenances thereunto  
to have and to hold the said land and premises hereby conveyed and all and singular  
part and parcel thereof unto him the said John Lumpkin his heirs and assigns  
ever in fee simple and unconditionally to him to his and their only proper  
use and behoof - And the said Nathaniel Hillyard do for himself, his heirs and assignees  
further covenant and agree to and with the said John Lumpkin his heirs and  
assigns, that he the said Nathaniel Hillyard his heirs executors and Administrators  
and parcel thereof unto him the said John Lumpkin his heirs and assigns  
by these presents warrant & forever defend against the right, title, claim  
of all and every person and persons whatsoever - In testimony whereof the said John  
Lumpkin do hereunto set his hand and affix his seal the day & date of the
