Brand the sum of one hundred twenty five dollars forty eight cents on the ninth day of January 1813, the further sum of One thousand two hundred four dollars fifty six cents on the same day, and \$100 on account of the within debt of trust. In consideration whereof, and whereas the said Oliver K. Brand has made of property in the within deed together with property on a part of a neighboring tract of land in the said Lipscomb to the same trustee for his benefit, to secure to him the payment of taxes now due from the said defendant to us without the within mentioned sum having been less than half acres of land, being the corner of claye William Estate of 169th acres in the said Lipscomb residue, and whereas the said defendant has for the same purpose sold land to the said Pollard; We do therefore, hereby relinquish and release from all right, title or interest in and to the said 169th acres of land on which the above is situated, so that the within Test. is never to operate or have any effect as it relates to a part of 169th acre of land as is herein particularly described from Pollard's Estate to us, but it is hereby understood that this relinquishment is not to affect our right and interest under the within test. as it relates to the other tracts of land therein mentioned, nor any right, interest or remedy under the deed above mentioned of a neighboring tract to the within test. Given under our hands this the 8th March 1813.

This instrument made this 9th day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirteen, Between Fleming Mitchell of the one part and Oliver K. Brand of the other part both of the County of King William, Witness in consideration of the sum of ten thousand three hundred dollars and the receipt whereof he left hereby acknowledged and agreed and set, and by these present doth grant, bargain and sell unto the said Fleming Mitchell the land out plantation lying and bounded by lot bearing date first of February One thousand eight hundred and thirteen, containing one acre and three rods bearing date 21st October 1810 of the County of King William, and containing according to survey
