hill and Jane Madison and their heirs forever by these presents will warrant
and forever defend In Witness whereof I hereunto set my hand fixed day and year the 31st
day of March 1806.

This Indenture made the 23rd day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and four between Samuel Garlick of the County of King William in the state of
Virginia of the one part and Robert B Hill of the County of King and Queen in the said state of
the other part witnesseth that whereas the said Samuel being indebted to the said Edward G Hill
of Pennsylvania did on the 23rd day of March one thousand eight hundred and four pay him to the
said Edward for thirty pounds current money of Virginia with a condition for the payment of forty
five pounds on or before the first day of October next ensuing the date thereof and also on the same
day did execute his bill present to the said Edward for the payment of one hundred dollars Virginia on
or before the first day of March next ensuing the date thereof under the penalty of two hundred
dollars which and true and full present has since been on the 25th day of July 1806 due and owing
