20 Re This Indenture made the 23rd day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and four Between Samuel Gartick of the County of King William in the State of
Virginia of the one part and Robert D Hill of the County of King and Queen in the said State of
the other part Witnesseth that whereas the said Samuel being indebted to one Edward G. Hill
of Spotsylvania Co on the 23rd day of March one thousand eight hundred and four his debt to the
said Edward for ninety pounds current money of England with a condition for the payment of forty
five pounds on or before the first day of October next ensuing the date thereof and also in the same
day did execute his last promissory to the said Edward for the payment of one hundred dollars upon
or before the first day of March next ensuing the date thereof under the penalty of two hundred
dollars which said last and last promissory has since been paid on the 25th day of July 1804 by the said
