 monies to the sum of two hundred and fifty one pounds eight shillings to the said
 William Nyatt he has in a sign and for full consideration of the sum of six shillings in hand
 paid by the said William Nyatt unto the said Reuben Atkins the receipt whereof he doth hereby
 acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and do by these presents grant bargain and sell
 unto the said William Nyatt all that tract piece or parcel of Land that he the said
 Reuben Atkins has lately purchased of the said William Nyatt and has received a conveyance
 which contains the boundaries thereof, containing one hundred and thirty seven acres and
 two thirds of an acre as a reference thereto will fully appear to have and to hold the
 said Land and premises hereby conveyed and all and every part and parcel thereof unto
 the said William Nyatt his heirs and assigns forever in free Absolute and unconditional
 simple to his & their only proper use and behoof. Provided always that should the said Reuben
 Atkins his heirs executors or assigns pay and discharge the said aforesaid bonds as they become
 due then and at all times thereafter this indenture to be null and void if otherwise to remain
