

Salem, Decr 1863

This Indenture made this third day of November Eighteen hundred and Sixty three between Richard Hill and Ann his wife of the County of King William of the Commonwealth of Virginia and Henry Harris and John Roane of the County of King William of the other parts whereof

as the said Richard Hill is indebted to the said John Roane in the sum of five thousand dollars to be paid on or before the first day of January eighteen hundred and eleven;

twelve with interest from the first day of January Eighteen hundred and eleven; one thousand dollars to be paid on the first day of January Eighteen hundred and thirteen, and

one thousand dollars from the first day of January eighteen hundred and eleven, One thousand dollars paid on the first day of January eighteen hundred and fourteen, with interest from the first day of January eighteen hundred and eleven, One thousand dollars to be paid on the first day of January eighteen hundred and fifteen, with interest from the first day of January eighteen hundred and eleven, One thousand dollars on the first day of January eighteen hundred and sixteen with interest from the first day of January eighteen hundred and sixteen.

The payment of which said several sums of money is secured by the said Richard Hill bonds bearing date the day of the execution of this deed. Now this Indenture witnesseth for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to the said Richard Hill

paid by the said Henry Harris the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged for the purpose of securing the payment of the said several sums of money due the said John Roane from the said Richard Hill as mentioned above, that the

Richard Hill and Ann Hill his wife have bargained and sold and do by the presents grant bargain, sell unto the said Henry Harris a certain tract, piece or parcel of land situate in the County of King William, and containing two hundred and eighty six acres more or less and bounded as appears by a deed from

John Roane and Elizabeth T. Roane his wife of the same date as this Indenture to the said Richard Hill with the appurtenances to the said tract of land

in any wise appertaining. To have and to hold the said tract of land

parcel of land with the promises and the appurtenances thereto belonging in

any wise appertaining unto him the said Henry Harris his heirs & assigns.

In trust nevertheless that the said Henry Harris shall in default of

paying one of the said Richard Hill's Bonds to the said John Roane when his bond respectively becomes due, for three months after they shall respectively become due at public sale for ready money the said tract, piece or parcel of land shall be advertised the sale of the said tract of land for two months before the day when the said Henry Harris shall be thereby exonerated by the said John Roane from many sums arising from the sale of the said tract of land after paying the said Richard Hill his bond.

and pay and satisfy the amount due on the said Bonds of the said Richard Hill and the money owing from the sale of the said land to the said John Roane and the said Henry Harris for myself my heirs & assigns.

The Commonwealth of Virginia to Philip Sytell, Walker Haws and James Cuttman Justices of King William County Greeting. Whereas Richard Hill and his wife have by their Indenture of Bargain and sale bearing date the third day of November and conveyed unto Henry Harris trustee for John Roane one certain tract of land containing by estimation two hundred and eighty six acres to the same more or less lying and being in the County of King William. And whereas the said Am White cannot conveniently travel to our County Court of King William to make payment of the said ~~comodatyance~~, Therefore we do give unto you or any two or more of you power to examine her privily and take her acknowledgement concerning the same aforesaid contained in the said Indenture which is hereto annexed, and we command you that you personally go to the said Am and examine her privily and apart from the said Richard Hill her husband concerning her executing the said Indenture her acknowledgement therupon, and when you have examined her as aforesaid her acknowledgement that you distinctly and plainly certify to us thereof in Court annexed to this Writ. witness Robert Pollard Clerk of our said Court 29th day of April 1811, in the 35th Year of the Commonwealth.
