same more or less and bounded as follows Beginning at a com-
er in the road adjoining the land of John King deceased thence
the said line to a corner white oak between Robert Blackwell's
King deceased and Champion Edwards and the said land thence along
to a fence and off white oak thence along the said line to a white oak

a fence and off dogwood thence along the said line to a corner white oak
thence along the said road to the beginning fence together with all land
singular its appurtenance To have and to hold the said tract piece or
parcel of land with all and singular its appurtenance unto him the said
Champion his heirs and assigns forever in fee simple and the said
Robert Blackwell for himself his heirs executors and administrators
the said tract piece or parcel of land and premises unto him the
said Champion Edwards his heirs or assigns forever do by these presents
warrant and forever defend against the claim or demand of
the said Robert Blackwell his heirs executors and administrators and an
and every other person or persons whatsoever I^m witness whereupon
the said Robert Blackwell has hereunto set his hand and affixed
his seal the day and year above mentioned
