

This Indenture made this 4<sup>th</sup> day of January in the 10<sup>th</sup> year of the said King William the first  
 and agreement between Theodorick B. Lipmont of the County of King William of the one part  
 and Tho: T. Scale of the County of the other part witnesseth that the said Theodorick B. Lipmont  
 for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars to him  
 in hand paid by the said Tho: T. Scale at or before his writing and delivery of these presents  
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents  
 do bargain and sell unto the said Thomas T. Scale his heirs and assigns a certain tract  
 parcel of Land lying in the aforesaid County, bounded as follows; beginning at the inter-  
 section of the branch dividing the land of Tho: Jones dec<sup>d</sup> from a tract in which some  
 thence up to the swamp thirty eight poles to a horn beam corner or south side of  
 said swamp; Thence N. 24. E. 200 poles to a corner white oak in Hill<sup>th</sup> & Blinn's  
 dec<sup>d</sup> Land. Thence S. 72. W. 100 poles to a tickling on the side of a branch corner  
 in the R. O'Brien line, thence down the meanders of said branch to its intersection  
 with the branch dividing the land of Thomas Jones dec<sup>d</sup> & said land and down  
 the meanders of said dividing branch to the beginning place supposed to be about one  
 hundred and fifty eight acres more or less, together with all the houses, buildings,  
 yards, gardens, orchards, lands, tenements, pastures, commons, woods, ways, waters  
 privileges profits and all and singular the appurtenances whatsoever to the said land  
 belonging. To have and to hold the said tract of land with the tenement's heredita-  
 ments and all and singular the premises herein before mentioned or intended to  
 be bargained and sold unto the said Tho: T. Scale his heirs and assigns forever.  
 And the said Theodorick B. Lipmont for himself his heirs the said tract of land  
 with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the  
 said Tho: T. Scale his heirs and assigns, free from the claim or claims of him the  
 said Theodorick B. Lipmont and his heirs and of all and every person or persons  
 whatsoever, shall will and do warrant and forever defend by these presents. In witness  
 whereof the said Theodorick B. Lipmont have hereunto set his hand and seal  
 the day and year first above written.
