

This Indenture made this 19 day of November 1810 between  
Thomas Garnett and Catharine his wife of the one part, and Robert Garnett  
and Mary T. his wife of the second part, and Joseph Grathmey of the third part  
and Hannah T. Dabney of the other part, all of the said parties residing in the  
County of King William Whereas that the said Thomas Garnett and  
Catharine his wife, and Robert Garnett and Mary T. his wife & Joseph  
Grathmey and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty five  
pounds Sterling money to them paid by the said Hannah T. Dabney as here-  
after mentioned, the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge, have  
granted bargained and sold to the said Hannah T. Dabney the Lands  
herein after mentioned situated in King William County and being  
part of the land wherein the late Mr Richard Grathmey did reside at  
the time of his decease, and being intended by this deed to be conveyed  
in pursuance of such sale as follows, to wit: Thirty five acres of Land,  
and also the Land wherein the dwelling house of the said Richard Grath-  
mey dece<sup>d</sup>. now stands, and the Land around adjoining the said Land  
on which the said dwelling house stands for twenty feet in width  
in every direction as it is situated around the said dwelling house  
And the said parties do by these presents grant, bargain & sell, alane  
release and confirm unto the said Hannah T. Dabney her heirs & assigns  
the said Land & premises to wit: the said thirty five acres of the said  
Land on which the said dwelling house is situated and the circumjacent  
Land as particularly described above, that is to say twenty acres so  
belonging to Thomas Garnett & Catharine his wife (being part of the  
said 35 acres) which was allotted on the division of the Land of the  
said Richard Grathmey dece<sup>d</sup> to the said Catharine as one of the daughters of  
the said Richard and sold as aforesaid for the sum of sixty pounds, and  
they acknowledge they have rec'd and also fifteen acres belonging to Robert  
Garnett and Mary T. his wife being part of the said 35 acres which was allotted  
on the division aforesaid to the said Mary T. as another of the daughters  
of the said Richard and sold as aforesaid for the sum of Fifty pounds  
which they have received, and also the said Land aforesaid whereon  
the said dwelling house is now situated and the circumjacent Land  
of the width of twenty feet in every direction as it is situated around  
the said dwelling house and as it is particularly described as aforesaid  
belonging to the said Joseph Grathmey and which was allotted on  
the division aforesaid to the said Joseph Grathmey as a son of  
the said Richard Grathmey and sold as aforesaid for the sum  
of fifty five pounds which he acknowledges to have received, which  
said division appears of record among the records of King William,

County Court. To have and to hold to them their heirs & assigns the said lands and premises and every part thereof together with all and singular their rights, members, privileges, immunities, improvements, ways, waters, boundaries and boundaries, alterations and reversions, hereditaments, appurtenances and appurtenances whatsoever belonging, or, in any wise appertaining to the only proper use and behoof of the said Hannah T. Dabney her heirs & assigns forever, and the said Thomas Garnett and Catharine his wife and Robert Garnett and the said Joseph and Joseph Gorattney do severally for themselves & their several & respective heirs executors & administrators grant covenant and agree to and with the said Hannah T. Dabney her heirs & assigns that they have severally a good right, and lawful title to sell and convey the said lands and premises according to the said allotments to them as herein aforesaid mentioned, & that the said Hannah T. Dabney her heirs and assigns shall and may at all times hereafter hold forsooth and enjoy them as hereby conveyed or intended to be conveyed according to the said respective sales according to the said respective allotments against the lawfull claim or demand of all and every person and persons whatsoever.
