

This Indenture made this 27th day of June in the
year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and eighteen
between Thomas Dabney trustee for John H. Taliaferro of the
County of King William of the one part, and John Glover
and William J. Glover both of the same County of the other part
Witnesseth that the said Thomas Dabney as trustee aforesaid in
consideration of the sum of One hundred and forty two dollars
and seventy five cents of lawful money of the Commonwealth
of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said John Glover
and William J. Glover at n before the sealing and delivery of
these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged)
hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain
and sell unto the said John Glover and William J. Glover
their heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land
lying and being in the County of King William aforesaid
Parish of Saint David, being a part of the tract of the late
whereof Fleming Blake dec^d died seized and containing
by a late Survey Thirty five acres and one rood, and more
as follows, viz: Beginning in the middle of the public
road, commonly called the ridge road, leading from the
golfick Church to Chylatts, corner to John H. Taliaferro
Richard Cockrains line, and running north fifty eight
East 102 poles to two pines saplings & two red oak saplings
pointers with s^r Cockrains, thence north 55 degrees
101 $\frac{1}{2}$ poles to a pine corner to the remainder of the land
whereof the said Blake died seized in line with
land belonging to the estate of W^m Glover dec^d thence
thirty two degrees west fifty one pole and one foot
to the middle of the aforesaid road, corner to
of the land whereof the said Blake died seized
with the land of said John H. Taliaferro
aforesaid road seventy five poles and one foot
with all and singular rights and appurtenances
thereunto in anywise belonging

thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto
John Glover and William J. Glover their heirs and assigns forever
to and for the only proper use and behoof of them the said
Glover and William J. Glover their heirs and assigns forever. And
the said Thomas Dabney as Trustee aforesaid for himself and
heirs the said tract or parcel of land and premises, with all and
singularity the appurtenances before mentioned unto the said John
Glover and William J. Glover their heirs and assigns, free from all
claim or claims of law the said Thomas Dabney and his heirs and
of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall will and do
warrant and forever defend by these presents.
