132 This Indenture made the first day of July in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and seven Between Thomas Johnson of the County of King William in the State of Virginia of the one part and James Gevan of the County of Henrico in the said State of the other part Witnesseth that the said Thomas Johnson for and in consideration of the sum of thirty nine pounds to him lent by the said James Gevan the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge and for the further consideration of securing to the said James the payment of the sum of thirty seven pounds seventeen shillings and 2 which were heretofore due and owing from the said Thomas to the said James his said Thomas hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said James two Negro men to wit George and Reuben To have and to hold the said Negroes unto the said James his heirs executors and assigns forever. Provided always and upon condition that if the said Thomas his heirs executors or assigns shall not and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said James his heirs executors or assigns the just and full sum of thirty nine pounds with Interest from the first day of July one thousand eight hundred and seven and the further sum of thirty seven pounds seventeen shillings and 2 with Interest from the said 1st day of July one thousand eight hundred and seven that then and from thence forth these presents and every thing herein contained shall cease determining and be void any thing herein contained to the contrary notwithstanding.
