

Know all men by these presents that whereas I Thomas Haughton being in custody of the Sheriff of King William County by virtue of two executions, to wit William Hill spec and Christopher Johnson spec, and being desirous of availing myself of the benefit of an act of the General assembly for the relief of insolvent debtors, for and in consideration of the premises & for other good and lawful considerations do hereby give, grant, and convey and by these presents do hereby according to the act of assembly in such case made and provided, give, grant and convey unto Philip Byggs Sheriff of King William County his heirs and assigns, full right, title, interest, claim and demand which I have, into or out of a certain piece parcel or tract of Land lying and being in the County aforesaid and in the Parish of St John and which was devised by my mother Betty Haughton by her last will and Testament, to George Haughton and Anne Haughton as trustees for my use. To have and to hold the said right title interest, claim and demand in to or out of the said above mentioned land to him the said Philip Byggs Sheriff as aforesaid his heirs and assigns forever. Given upon under my hand and seal this 22nd Sept 1817.
