

Indenture made the 28 day of July in the
 of our Lord 1807 Between Thomas Mitchell and Anna
 of the court of King & Queen of the one part and William
 Madiren of the County of King William of the other part
 witness that the said Thomas Mitchell and Anna his wife
 and in consideration of the sum of ten pounds to them
 hand paid by the said William Madiren the receipt whereof
 they do hereby acknowledge have bargained sold aliened
 enfeoffed & confirmed and do by their presents bargain
 sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said William Madiren
 his heirs and assigns some certain tract piece or parcel of
 Land situate lying and being in the County of King
 William and parish of Saint David containing by a survey
 made by John Fox fifteen Acres and three sevenths of an Acre
 be the same more or less and bounded by the Lands of William
 Coggan and the Lands of the College of William and Mary
 designated by the number 4 in the plat thereof made by the
 said John Fox which is hereby for greater certainty referred to
 together with all and singular the Hereditaments and appurtenances
 thereto the same belonging or in any wise appertaining to
 have and to hold the said tract piece or parcel of Land
 together with all and singular the appurtenances unto the
 said William Madiren his heirs and assigns forever; free and
 clear of and from all manner of incumbrances whatsoever
 and the said Thomas Mitchell and Anna his wife for them
 selves their heirs executors and administrators do covenant
 and engage the above described Land and premises to him
 the said William Madiren his heirs and assigns against
 the claim and demands of all persons whatsoever forever hereafter
 to do warrant and defend by their presents. In Witness whereof

Justices of King William County greeting Whome these shall come
Forasmuch as we have by this certain Indenture of bargain and
sale bearing date the 28 day of July 1807 sold and conveyed
unto William Madison a certain tract or parcel of land
containing fifteen three fourths Acre and appurtenances lying
in the county of King William and whereas the said land
cannot conveniently be sold to the Court of the said County
King William to make a acknowledgment of the said Indenture

Therefore we do give unto you or any two or more of your
power to receive the acknowledgment which the said Owner
shall be willing to make of the conveyance aforesaid contained
in the said Indenture which is annexed and we do therefore
command you that you do personally go to the said Owner
and receive his acknowledgment of the same, and examine him
privily and apart from his said husband, whether she doth
the same freely and voluntarily without his persuasions
or threats and whether she be willing that the same may
be recorded in our County Court of King William aforesaid
and when you have received his acknowledgment, and ex-
amined him as aforesaid that you distinctly and openly
certify in this manner in our Court under your seals sending the
Indenture with Petre's Seal Pollard Clerk of our said
County the 29 day of July 1807 in the 32nd year of our said
King William County &c

XVII 1807 By virtue of this writ to us and others
directed we did personally go to the said Owner the wife of
Thomas Mitchell and examined her privily and apart from
her said husband and she acknowledged the Indenture

untarily without the persuasions or threats of her said hus-
