said Thomas Johnson and Sally Lewis his wife for and in consideration of the
sum of one hundred dollars to them in hand paid the receipt whereof they
do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents
grant bargain and sell unto the said Robert Blackwell a certain piece
of parcel of land lying and being in the County aforesaid and parish of Saint
Dunstons part of the land known by the name of Whitehead containing by estimate
seventy six and a half acres or more or less and bounded as follows
beginning at a corner betwixt Allen Blackwell and the said land
from thence along a line betwixt the land of Henry Thwait ditto and the
