Henrico of the One part, and Edmund Littlepage of the County of King
William of the Other part, Witnesseth, that the said Chamberlayne for and
in consideration of the sum of One hundred and thirty pounds Virginia Cur-
rancy to him in hand paid, at or before the executing and delivery of
this presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and for the further
consideration of Six shillings, the receipt whereof is also hereby acknowledged
hath granted bargained and sold, and by these presents doth grant bargain
and sell unto the said Littlepage, all that tract or parcel of land
lying and being in the County of King William containing by survey of
John Acers, be the same more or less, bounded by the land of Benjamin
Lucas, James Ruffin, Alexander Smith and the land of the said Littlepage
attached to Coloke mill and being a part of the tract formerly owned
David Pammel and which was assigned to Edw. P. Chamberlayne and by the
said Pammel and to hold the said tract or parcel of land to him the said Little-
page and his heirs forever. And the said Chamberlayne doth
himself warrant to defend and save harmless, him the said Littlepage
himself in the free use and possession of the said tract of land free
from all molestation of him the said Chamberlayne and heirs, and of
other persons whatsoever. In Witness whereof the said Chamberlayne hath
