said Christopher Johnson the Receipt whereof I do hereby acknow-
ledge and chief acquit and discharge the said Chris Johnson
his heirs Executors & administrators. He the said William D Chamblayne
layne have granted Bargained & sold unto the said Chris Johnson
his heirs & assigns forever all that certain Tract ^{piece} or parcel of
land that I receive from the Estate of my dec^d parents as
my proportion lying & being in the parish & County aforesaid,
and bounded by the lands that was allotted to Spotswood D
Chamblayne, Perims, Mat pony River & fixen ferry land con-
taining by Estimation three hundred & five acres be the same
more or less according to its intent & reputed Bounds. To have
