The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound William T. Fleet has been appointed Commissioner of the revenue for the County of King William. Now if the said Wm T. Fleet shall well and truly perform all the duties required by law as Commissioner aforesaid then this obligation to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue.

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This Indenture made and entered into this 1st day of February in the year of our Lord aughteen hundred and fifteen between Thomas Bottrell of one part and William R. Bottrell of the other part all of the County of King William and Parish of St. Pauls Metrop^{ol} that whereas William Bottrell dec^d has by his last will and Testament bequeathed has been duly proved and recorded in the Court of the County aforesaid, bequeathed the said William his son of an inheritance in his estate by bequeathing him the sum of six shillings and that the said Thomas will by the said last will and testament on the donation of the said estate be entitled to one fifth part of the said estate, and that by the said last will and testament and the said Thomas in Consideration of paternal love and affection and in further love and Consideration of the sum of one dollar the said Thomas have paid to the said Thomas on the said William before the executing and delivery of these presents the sum of one dollar which is hereby acknowledged by him the said Thomas and by the said William there for ever forgiven and acquitted and for these other good and lawful Considerations both the said bargain and sold and by these presents both Thomas bargain and sold unto the said William his heirs assigns and assigns one undivided sixth part of the real and personal estate which the said Thomas is entitled to under the will of the said William Bottrell dec^d is his distributable part of his estate and one undivided fifth part of the real and personal estate which the said Thomas is entitled to under the will of the said William dec^d as his distributable part of the said estate of the said estate of the said William dec^d which lies in the County and Parish aforesaid and in which estate Beverly Robinson Esq^r has qualified as executor with all and singular the tenements hereditaments and appurtenances to the same belonging or in anywise appertaining and the revenue and revenues remainder and remainders of every part and parcel thereof to have and to hold the said undivided sixth part of the distributable portion of the said Thomas Bottrell in the said estate of the said William dec^d and the said undivided sixth part with all singular the tenements hereditaments and appurtenances and other the premises herein before mentioned to be bargain and sold and every part and parcel thereof unto him the said William R. Bottrell his heirs assigns executors administrators and assigns for ever in fee simple and the said Thomas do hereby for himself any heirs executors administrators and assigns warrant and confirm the title to the above conveyed property to him the said William his heirs and assigns against the claim or claims of themselves their heirs and assigns for ever and the said Thomas do hereby for himself his heirs executors and administrators warrant confirm grant and agree to and with the said William R. Bottrell his heirs executors and administrators

in witness and form following that is to say that for the consideration aforesaid that as soon as a deed should be obtained of the said estate of the said estate of the said William Collinell do^t conveying of both Real and personal property, which is now in the hands of the executor of the said William do^t that if the said one of the legates of the said William do^t shall not agree to the same that the said Thomas Collinell will assign the said William R. Collinell to take a distributable part of the estate of the said William do^t as far as the same relates to his interest in the said estate in the same manner as if the said William had been a legatee by the said William do^t & that the said William R. Collinell shall take some share for himself his own share nominally and assign for ever in fee simple one undivided sixth part of the Real and personal estate of the said William do^t which the said Thomas shall be entitled to his distributable part, to which the said Thomas shall be entitled in the said estate of the said William do^t according to the intent and meaning and such is now declared to be the true intent and meaning of the foregoing words.
