The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound William T. Steel is lawfully appointed Commissioner of the revenue for the County of King William. Now if the said Wm T. Steel shall well and truly perform all the duties required by law as Commissioner aforesaid then this obligation to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue.

This Indenture made and entered into this 7th day of February in the year of our Lord aughteen hundred and fifteen between Thomas Cottrell of one part and William R. Cottrell of the other part all of the County of King William and Parish of St. Pauls Metrop^olitan that whereas William Cottrell dec^d has by his last will and Testament beforesaid been duly proved and recorded in the Court of the County aforesaid, bequeathed the said William his son of an inheritance in his estate by law being the sum of six shilling and that the said Thomas will by the said last will and testament on the donation of the said estate be entitled to one fifth part of the said estate, and that by the said last will and testament and the said Thomas in Consideration of paternal love and affection and in further love and Consideration of the sum of one dollar the said Thomas have paid to the said Thomas on the said William before the executing and delivery of these presents the sum of six shilling which is hereby acknowledged by him the said Thomas and by the said William hereof for ever bargained and concluded and for divers other good and lawful Considerations both the said bargained and sold and by these presents with ~~and~~ bargain and sold unto the said William his heirs executors and assigns one undivided sixth part of the real and personal estate which the said Thomas is entitled to under the will of the said William Cottrell dec^d in his distributable part of his estate and one undivided fifth part of the real and personal estate which the said Thomas is entitled to under the will of the said William dec^d as his distributable part of the said estate of the said estate of the said William dec^d which lies in the County and Parish aforesaid and in which estate Beverly Robinson Esq^r has qualified as executor with all and singular the tenements hereditaments and appurtenances to the same belonging or in anywise appertaining and the revenues and reveries remainder and remainders of every part and parcel thereof to have and to hold the said undivided sixth part of the distributable portion of the said Thomas Cottrell in the said estate of the said William dec^d and the said undivided sixth part with all singular the tenements hereditaments and appurtenances and other the premises herein before mentioned to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof unto him the said William R. Cottrell his heirs executors administrators and assigns for ever in fee simple and the said Thomas do hereby for himself any heirs executors administrators and assigns warrant and confirm the title to the above conveyed property to him the said William his heirs and assigns against the claim or claims of themselves their heirs and assigns for ever and the said Thomas do hereby for himself his heirs executors and administrators warrant confirm grant and agree to and with the said William R. Cottrell his heirs executors and administrators

in witness whereof following that is to say that for the consideration aforesaid that as soon as a deed
 be obtained of the said estate of the said estate of the said William Cottrell dec'd consisting of both Real
 personal property interests as aforesaid in the hands of the executor of the said William dec'd that if the said
 of the legatee of the said William dec'd said not agree to the same that the said Thomas Cottrell will
 against the said William R. Cottrell to take a distributable part of the estate of the said William dec'd
 as far as the same relates to his interest in the said estate in the same manner as if the said William
 had been a legatee by the said William dec'd that the said William R. Cottrell shall take no share for
 himself his own executor administrators and assigns for ever in fee simple one undivided sixth part of
 the Real and personal estate of the said William dec'd of which the said Thomas shall be entitled to
 his distributable part, to which the said Thomas shall be entitled in the said estate of the said
