

This Indenture made this 26 day of Sept 1816, between  
 the County of King W<sup>m</sup> and Herbert A. Claiborne of the City of Richmond of the one  
 and William D. Browne of the County of King William of the other part Witnesseth that  
 the said W<sup>m</sup> P. Claiborne and Herbert A. Claiborne in consideration of the sum of five  
 dollars to them in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged; have this  
 day, bargained, sold, and delivered, and by these presents do hereby, bargain, sell  
 deliver, alien, assign and confirm to him the said W<sup>m</sup> D. Browne, his heirs and assigns  
 forever, a certain piece parcel or tract of land, lying and being in the 2<sup>d</sup> County of  
 King William, & in the Parish of St. John, containing one hundred acres, be the  
 same more or less; the metes and boundaries whereof, are as follow, to wit: From  
 the point at which Knight's swamp intersects the line, dividing the College Land from  
 the patent lands; down the said line, which is now the line of W<sup>m</sup> Longbottom's estate  
 until it strikes Sacks creek; from thence down the windings of the said creek to  
 the mouth of Knight's swamp, which distinguishes its self into the said creek; and  
 from thence up the said creek to the beginning; all of which will more fully appear  
 by a reference <sup>to</sup> a deed from the said Browne to the said Herbert A. Claiborne, dated  
 the 25<sup>th</sup> of Aug<sup>r</sup> 1807 and now of record in the office of King William. To have  
 and to hold the said tract or parcel of land afores<sup>d</sup> with all and singular the  
 tenements, appurtenances and appurtenances, with the remainder and remainder, and  
 person and reversions, hereditaments and other words, issues and profits, thereto belonging  
 or in any wise appertaining to him the said William D. Browne, his heirs and  
 assigns forever in full and absolute fee simple, to the only proper use and behoof  
 of him the said William D. Browne, his heirs and assigns forever. In testimony  
 whereof they the said William P. Claiborne and Herbert A. Claiborne hath hereunto set  
 their hands and affixed their seals, the day and year first above written.
