this my Last Will & Testament in manner & form
following: vizt in a first place I give & Resign
my Soul to God Almighty my Creator in hopes
through my Repentance & Faith in Christ
my Redeemer that my sins will be forgiven
& that I shall be saved; & my body I will to be
cently buried in a little charge as reasonably
may be. And as to my worldly estate I dispose
of as follows vizt: first I give to my son John
Sanders One good Colting & Trooper saddle
& Bridle ^{with} all fit to riding Troop. And my
French Furze: Two Dews & Lambs: One
young Cow: all of about 7. Shilings or Leguins
to be paid to my s^r son when he shall come to
of age of eighteen years.

Item I give to my Daughter Elizabeth Sanders One
of my best Beds & a Rugs pair of Blankets &
Colts. One Cow of three years old either with
Calf or a Calf by her side: Two Dews & Lambs
of about 7. Leguins given to my s^r Daughter Elizabeth
to be paid ^{at} day of her Marriage Calf
to be paid ^{at} day of her Marriage Calf

To Lovell Legaire at their Lovell age of twine
One year.

Item I give to of Child my wife now goes, & if it shall
be a Girl a young mare: if it shall be a Boy
a young horse of these years old to be paid of
To Child when it shall come to of age of fifteen
years.

Item All the Rest of my Estate I give to be divided
between my Loving wife Margarite Landers
& of Child the now goes, with this to have
Three Quarters & of Child One Quarter.

Item I make my Loving wife Margarite Landers
Executrix of this my Last will & Testament
hereby revoking all former wills & Testaments
whatsoever

Item I do appoint my Loving friend Thomas
Pitman Overseeer of this my
Last will to see that my Children may
not be Wronged: & if my wife shall
marry that she shall give good Security
to of Child Thomas for payment of a Legaire
to my Lovell Children according to this
will

Thomas I make my Loving Wife Margarite Landers
Executing of this my Last will & Testament
hereby revoking all former wills & Testaments
whatsoever

Item I do appoint my Loving friend Thomas
