Testament in manner and forme following. And first and principally I comend
my Soul into the hands of almighty God trusting and assuredly that through
the Meritorious death and passion of my blessed Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ
to receive full pardon and remission for all my sins and to inherit Eternall
Life in the Kingdom of Heaven. And my body commits to the Earth from
whence it was taken to be buried in such decent and Christian Manner
as my Executors hereafter named shall think fit

Item I will and desire that all my Just debts and funerall Expences be
first paid, and satisfied

Item I give unto my Dear and Loving Son William Fox two Negroes by Name
York and Bobb with all their future increase to him and his heirs forever

Item I give unto my Said Dear and Loving Son William Fox one white boant
Boy named James Dawson

Item I give unto my Dear and Loving Son Samuel Fox four Negroes by Name
Tom, Dyna, Toney and Judy with all their future increase to him and his
heirs forever

Item I give unto my Said Dear and Loving Son Samuel Fox one white boant
Boy named Phillip Ffroid

Item I give unto my Said Dear and Loving Son Samuel Fox my black gold-
ing namedolly

Item I give unto my Dear and Loving Daughter Hannah Spelman two Negroes
by Name Gloster and Lancaster with all their future increase to her and her
heirs forever

- Item I give unto my Dear and Loving Son William Fox two Negroes by Name York and Bess with all their future increase to him and his heirs forever
- Item I give unto my Said Dear and Loving Son William Fox one white boy named James Dawson
- Item I give unto my Dear and Loving Son Samuel Fox four Negroes by Name Tom, Dyna, Toney and Judy with all their future increase to him and his heirs forever
- Item I give unto my Said Dear and Loving Son Samuel Fox one white boy named Phillip Brown
- Item I give unto my Said Dear and Loving Son Samuel Fox my black gelding named Ally
- Item I give unto my Dear and Loving Daughter Hannah Spelman two Negroes by Name Glaston and Tony with all their future increase to her and her heirs forever
- Item I give unto my Said Dear and Loving Daughter Hannah Spelman my gray gelding called Robin to and her assigns forever
- Item I give unto my Said Dear and Loving Daughter Hannah Spelman all my wearing apparel of what Nature or quality so ever
- Item It is my will and desire that what money and Tobacco I have in London together with the produce of my Tobacco sent for London by the last Fleet be equally divided between my Dear and Loving Sons William and Samuel Fox
- Item It is my will that the goods sent for upon the produce of two hogheads of Tobacco sent to Liverpool be equally divided between my Said Dear and Loving Sons William and Samuel Fox and my Daughter Hannah Spelman only

only one piece of stuff sent for I give unto my said Daughter Hannah Spelman
a Gown and petticoat off over and above her proportion of the said goods and
all the remainder of the said pieces of stuff I give to my grand Daughter Lettice
Fox —

Item It is my will and desire that my crop of Tobacco which I have now in hand
when finished be shipped by my Executors hereafter named upon the proper
account and request of my estate and consigned to Arthur Bailey Esq. Merchant
in London and the net produce of my said Tobacco when sold to be equally
divided between my said Dear and Loving Sons William and Samuel Fox —

Item It is my will that what goods I have in the house be applyed in cloathing of
my Servants this Winter and that the Remainder of the said goods be equally
divided between my said Sons William and Samuel Fox only filed
thousand twenty penny Nails I give unto my Son Samuel Fox over and
above his proportion of the remainder of the said goods —

Item I give unto my Dear and Loving Daughter Hannah Spelman my Mulletto
Girl Hannah Dennis to serve her five years after the determination
of a Right Capt. William Ball claimer to the said Hannah Dennis, and
in case the said Ball does not recover her. It is my will that after the
Expiration of the said term of five years as aforesaid the said
Hannah Dennis shall be free —

Item Whereas my husband Capt. David Fox dec'd. did by his last will and Testament
in writing amongst sundry bequests therein mentioned give unto my
Son Samuel Fox all the furniture of three Rooms as it then stood to wit
the two Lower Rooms in the great house and his Lodging chamber —

comonly called the old chamber the chest of Drawers the Cloathes
press the hat press and the chest of drawers only excepted —

above his ^{poor Samuel} portion of the remainder of the said goods —
Item I give unto my Dear and Loving Daughter Hannah Spelman my Mulatto
girl Hannah Dennis to serve her five years after the determination
of a Right Captⁿ William Ball claimer to the said Hannah Dennis, and
in case the said Ball does not recover her. It is my will that after the
Expiration of the said term of five years as aforesaid the said
Hannah Dennis shall be free.

Item Whereas my husband Captⁿ David Fox dec^d did by his last will and Testament
in writing amongst sundry bequests therein mentioned, give unto my
Son Samuel Fox all the furniture of three Rooms as it then stood to wit
the two lower Rooms in the great house and his Lodging chamber —
commonly called the old chamber (the chest of Drawers the Cloaths
except the hat press and part of the guns only excepted) Now it is
my will and desire that in case my Son William Fox after my
decease shall deliver unto my Son Samuel Fox upon demand all
the furniture of the said three Rooms according to the purport intent
and true meaning of his fathers said will that then and in such case
Fox shall stand good to him and his heirs but if my said Son William
Fox shall refuse to deliver unto my said Son Samuel Fox the
furniture of the said three Rooms according to the purport intent &
true meaning of his fathers said will then I do declare all the Legacies
bequeathed in this my will given unto my Son William Fox to be void
to all intents and purposes and I give the said legacies to my Son
Samuel Fox

And Lastly I do hereby make ordains constitute and
 appoint my Dear and Loving Son William Fox and Samuell
 Fox and my kinsman William Steward to be Executors of this
 my last will and Testament and I do hereby revoke and make
 null and void all former wills by me heretofore made &
 this only to be my last will and Testament in witness
 whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 3rd
