Winifred Wells and her heirs as aforesaid for ever and in default of such Issue
to descend and fall unto George Mitchell son of Robert Mitchell late of this
County of Lancast deceased and his heirs as aforesaid for ever
Item I give and bequeath unto my son John Wells one father bed curtains

Item I give and Bequeath unto my daughter Sarah Wells one father Bed and fur

Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Sarah Wells one feather Bed and fur
niture now in the Chamber over my head.

Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter ~~Winifred~~ Winifred Wells, one flock bed and fu
niture.

Item I give and bequeath unto my dear and loving wife Hannah Wells one
white horse.

Item I give and bequeath unto my son John Wells my young Bay mare.

Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Sarah Wells my old mare.

Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Winifred Wells my horse (all now Running
with my old mare).

Item I give and bequeath all the Residue of my Estate goods (Cattel and Chattels) to they
movables or Immoveables or in whomsoever's possession custody or Keeping they now are
or hereafter may be found unto my 2d wife and three Children before named to be
Equally divided between my 2d wife and Children.

Item I will and ordaine that my son John Woll and my daughter Winifred both Immedi-
ately after they decede be taken into the care and tuition of my Cousin ~~Woll~~ John Mills
and my ~~so~~ son there to be and Remaine until he arrive unto the age of Twenty years
and my ~~so~~ daughter Winifred until she be of the full age of fifteen years together
all and singular the legacies, boons, gifts, or gratifications given or bequeathed unto them
John and Winifred in this my last will and testament
Item I will and ordaine that my daughter Sarah Woll shall be and Remaine with
my dear and loving wife Hannah Woll until shee arrive unto the age of fifteen years
together with all her legacies or gifts whatsoe^r given or bequeathed unto her in this my
will and Testament
Item I nominate constitute appoint and ordaine my well beloved Brother John Mott and
Loving Cousin John Mills to be Joint Executors of this my last will and Testament Ratify
and confirming this and none other to be my last will and Testament. In witness whereof
