will: viz: I give to william ackers. one bed and
blankets & a rug: with her now lying on: —

I then I give & bequeath to Susana burton daughter
to John burton: the tract of land now lying out after
my wifes decesse and yet by fifty acres and one two year
old ~~plantation~~ to be sold to her father John burton to be
kept by him for his sd daughter till shee come to age or
married:

estate to my deare and loving wife Susana Witt my
Executrix: Reserving all other wills by mee made
that this my last will: two stand:
