appurtenances unto my said Daughter & her heirs for ever

I Item I give and Bequeath unto my said Daught Anne Stoward the other
moiety of my Lands after the Decease of my wife To have and To hold
the said Land & Appurtenances unto my said Daughter & her heirs for ever

I Item I give and Bequeath all and singular the Residue of my Personall
Estate goods Chattell and Chattells to be Equally Divided between my wife
and my Daught ~~and~~ Anne Stoward; and I do nominate and ordain
my wife Thob Draper sole Excutrix of this my Last will & Testament
Revoking and annulling all other former wills or Testam^{ts} Ratifying and
Confirming this to be my Last will and Testam^{ts}; In witness
