to be livered at the spring two tables two pots & all so
I give him all my wearing clothes

Itt I give to my daughter Ruth one flock bed & bolster
& one ~~ch~~ kilt

Itt I give unto my three sons in law one shilling apiece &
no more

Itt I give unto my son Nicholas my Christian wife

Itt I give to my two sons Emory & William George one
shilling apiece

Itt I doe heare by Homynate And appoint my loving wife
Elizabeth George & my son Benjamin George to be my
sole Executors of this my last will & Testament And
doe heare by Revoke all former wills in witness where
of I have heare unto set my hand & seal this 9 day of
March 1699
