In the name of god Amen this twenty third Day of September
one thousand seven hundred and sixe I Peter Willgon of the above
County being sick and weak of body but of sound and perfect memo-
ry praised be almighty god and knowing the uncertainty of this
mortall life doe hereby make stablish and ordain this to be my last
will and testament hereby Revoking all former wills and Deeds and
Deeds of gifts In this manner and form and this only to remain
as my last will

Firstly I give and bequeath my soule into the hands of almighty god my
maker trusting and hoping through the merits of Jesus Christ my
Saviour and Redeemer to have full pardon and Remission of all
my sins and commit my body to the earth from whence it was re-
taken desiring to be decently Interred as my son Peter and
executor shall thinke fitt

Secondly I give and bequeath to my son John and his heirs for ever
shall be that part where John shall lately dye and to be equally di-
vided between my son Peter and my son John and that my son
Peter shall help him to build a twenty foot dwelling fitt to live in so soon
as my son shall require it after this year and that my son Peter
shall be at least half the charge aboute building this house

Thirdly I bequeath my personally estate as followeth that all my moveable
Estate be equally divided between my four Children Peter
John Ann and Margaret further my desire is that if Margaret
shall once in three years make then good to my daughter Margaret
my will and desire is that In case of untimely or death of either
of my Children then what they have hereby bequeathed to be equally
divided amongst the survivors

Fourthly I bequeath the plantation that I now live on with all the houses
long orchard and all other appurtenances and hereunto
belonging unto my son Peter and ~~executor~~ my executor and
that my daughter Margaret shall live with my son Peter
until she com to age or married and then to deliver her to
her the share which I have bequeathed unto her

Further my desire is that my son John shall have his share
before he comes to the age of sixteen years and to
deliver unto my daughter Ann her share before she comes to the age
or the day of marriage further my desire is that
my son John and my daughter Ann shall be confined to stay
with my son Peter to years after my decease and to be under
his care and tuition except they can show a lawful reason

Lastly my desire is that after my death my debts and expences that my deceased
be paid in every article and clause of this my last will
and testament that he see every thing there contained duly
and truly performed and fulfilled and do hereby and more make
void and of none effect all former wills and testaments and this
only to stand and remain in full efficacy power and force

the day and year first above written between the foretold

and between the lines first and the one the lines second
Interlined (and his legs for ever) before signing and sealing
