will and Testament in manner and forme following

I commend my soul unto the hands of almighty god who gave it me
and my Body to be Buried in Christian and Decent manner at the discretion of my Executors
hereafter named and as for what Estate god hath been please to bless ^{me} with in this life I give
and dispose it as followeth: Ibm I give and Bequeath unto my youngest son Thomas Young
one mill called and known by the name of Moraticoe mill situate at the head of Moraticoe Creek
in the County of Lancaster aforesaid with all the appurtenances thereto belonging or appertaining unto
him and his heirs for ever Ibm I give and bequeath unto my d^d son Thomas Young and his heirs for ever
my Plantation where I now dwell upon house and land situate in the County of Lancaster aforesaid
containing one hundred and fifty Acres situate in the County of Lancaster aforesaid
Ibm I give and Bequeath unto my eldest son Bryan Young and his heirs one negro man called
mingo and one negro Boy called maddy as also one feather bed Rugg and Blanket; Ibm I give
and bequeath unto my youngest son Thomas Young one negro woman called Frank and one
white slave by name John Bradford; Ibm I give and bequeath unto my eldest son Bryan Young
fifteen head of Cattle to be some of them Cowes and some young Cattle suitable out of my stock
Ibm I give and bequeath unto my youngest son Thomas Young all the Residue of my goods
Cattle and Chattels whome I do constitute and ordain to be sole Executor of this my last will and
Testament Ratifying and confirming this and none other to be my last will and Testament as
witness my hand and seal the Thirteenth day of April Anno Domini 1705
