will & Testament disannulling and making void all other Wills by me formerly made
and this only to be taken for my last Will and Testament dated this twenty fourth day
of March anno: 1704 In manner and forme following. first I bequeath my Soul to God
I gave it. trusting in the Merits of my blessed Saviour Jesus Christ. to obtain full pardon
of all my sins. And my body to y^e Earth from whence it was taken to be decently bur-
ied at the discretion of my Executor hereafter named, with the advice of my loving
wife: Itm I give and bequeath unto my son Hen: Lanson one parcell or tract of
Land situate lying & being in Lancaster County & parish of Christ Church, beginning
at the foot of Creeple hill running due North to the extent of my Land, that is to say
the Easterly part of my Land: my son Henery to have and hold the said Land to him and
his heirs for ever, But in case my son Henery or his heirs shall at any time hereafter
offer to make sale or lease the said Land or any part thereof: for any longer time then
one yeare or from year to year: That then my son Rowland Lanson or in case of his
death his heirs: presently to enter & take possession of the said Land & it to have & hold
to there proper use for ever: Itm I appoynt my son Rowland Lanson sole Executor of
this my last Will & Testament. and to have the sole Managment of my affairs in Eng-
land and without giving any account of the same. Itm. my will is that my personall
Estate to be Equally divided according as the Law of this Country have provided. But
my loving wife to have her first choyce and my children to have their
choyce as they are in age In Witness hereof I have set my hand & seale,
