them when they come to age I give unto my son Benjamin
Morrison one Negro woman named Melquo
I give unto my Son the young William Morrison the plantation
that he now lives on for his Life time and to make use of
the timber on for the plantations use but not to sell any
and the Rest of my estate to be Equally Divided amongst
them all Boys and Girls
I leave
for my loving wife Elinnor ~~Morrison~~ Henry Toler to
be Executor to this my Last will and testament as witness
my hand this 19th day of July in the year of our Lord
God 1718 in the presence of
