

Case No. 20. March 2. 1800.
This Indenture made the twenty fourth day of January One thousand eight hundred & twenty three between Josiah Dozier of the County of Lee & State of Virginia of the one part & Isaac Craigon of the same County & State of the other part Witnesseth, that the said Josiah Dozier for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred & ten Dollars to him in hand paid hath bargained & sold a certain tract or parcel of land in the County & State aforesaid, containing thirty five acres lying & being on the waters of Trading Creek bounded by land of Joseph Thomas on the west side of the same Beginning at a white oak on the side of a hill & on the west side of said Creek running thence S 72 west thirty five poles to a stake thence north 70 west One hundred & sixty poles to a stake thence north 72 East thirty five poles till it intersects a dividing line between the lands of said Thomas & said Josiah Dozier thence south 7 east to the first station Together with its appurtenances to the said Isaac Craigon & his heirs to the sole use & behoof of him the said Isaac Craigon & his heirs forever the said Josiah Dozier for himself & his heirs doth covenant with

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said Josiah Dozier thence south & east to the first station Together
with its appurtenances to the said Isaac Braigon & his heirs to the
sole use & behoof of him the said Isaac Braigon & his heirs forever
the said Josiah Dozier for himself & his heirs doth covenant with
the said Isaac Braigon & his heirs that he the said Josiah Dozier &
his heirs the said land with all its appurtenances into the said
Isaac Braigon & his heirs against all persons whatsoever will forever
warrant & defend in Witness whereof the said Josiah Dozier hath
herunto subscribed his name & affixed his seal the day & year above
written.

W. Miller D. C.

This Indenture made the twenty eight day of January in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and Twenty three Between Isaac Christman of Lee County and State of Virginia of the one part and Clemmel Woodard of the County and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that he the said Isaac Christman and Sally his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and fifty dollars current money of Virginia to them in hand paid the receipt whereof they doth hereby acknowledge have granted bargained sold and
