

This Indenture made the twenty second day of October 1792
between and between Samuel Graybill Merchant of New County and
State of Kentucky of the one part and John Graybill of the State of
Virginia and Hamilton County of the other part Witnesseth that the said
Samuel Graybill for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred and ten
Pounds to him in hand paid, doth bargain and sell one certain tract or parcel
of land in the County of Lee and State of Virginia containing two hundred
and forty six acres lying and being on the Waters of Trading Creek on both sides
of the Kentucky River and bounded as follows to wit, Beginning on the
West side of a Ridge at two White Oaks thence South Six Degrees East 100 Rods
to two White Oaks and a Dogwood on the South side of a Ridge North 72 degrees
East 50 Rods so as to John William Bryance Land of Seventy acres North 6
Degrees West 100 Rods Remaining with the Bryance Land, thence leaving said
land South 72 West 250 Rods to the Beginning. Witnesseth that the said
Samuel Graybill doth hold the above tract of land to the said John Graybill and his heirs,
to the sole use and behoof of him the said John Graybill and

planned to hold the same as a race or fair, with the attendance to the said
Graybill and his heirs, to the sole use and behoof of him the said John Graybill and
his heirs forever, and the said Samuel Slaughter for himself and his heirs doth con-
sent with the said John Graybill and his heirs that he the said Samuel Slaughter and
his heirs the said land with all the appurtenances unto the said John Graybill and
his heirs against all persons whatever with full power, warrant and defense in writing
whereof the said Samuel Slaughter hath hereunto subscribed his name and affixed
his seals the day and year above written.
