

In the Name of God Amen I Anne Lee of Landon County being weak and feeble of Body but of sound mind and perfect memory Thanks be to Almighty God for the same and knowing the uncertainty of this Transitory Life and the certainty of Death, and being willing to settle my worldly affairs, and prevent disputes that may arise after my death to make and Ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following. First and principally I Recommend my Soul into the hands of Almighty God that have it, hoping that through the Merits and intercession of Jesus Christ to obtain Remission of my sins and my Body to the earth to be Buried at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named, and as for my worldly Estate which hath pleased God to bless me with I give and devise as follows. I Give and Bequeath to my son John Lee one feather Bed & furniture to him his heirs and assigns forever. I Give to my Daughter Susanna Carpenter wife of Jonathan Carpenter, one feather Bed and Furniture to her heirs forever. I Give to my son Francis Wainwright Lee one feather Bed and Furniture which he has now in possession, and to his heirs forever. I Give my son Francis Lee one Bed and furniture which he has now in possession to him his heirs forever. I Give my Will and Desire that all the Rest of my Estate be it of what nature or quality soever be equally Divided between my two Children John Lee & Susanna Carpenter and lastly by it is my Desire that my son John Lee be Executor of this my last Will & Testament hereby Revoking and Disannulling all other and former Wills, Devises, & bequests by me heretofore made and Declaring this only to be my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this fifteenth Day of September 1720 (I desire my Estate may not be appraised or Inrolled Published & Declared in presence of

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A Court held for Lonsdale County the 12th Day of May 1793
This Will was this Day Presented in Court by John Lier the Executor therein
