Dec^d do make or Cause to be made a true and perfect
Inventory of all and Singular the Goods Chattels
and Credits of the sd Dec^d Which have or shall
Come to the hands Possession or Knowledge of the
th^d Judith Anderson or into the hands or Possession
of any other Person or Persons for her and the
same as made do Exhibit or Cause to be Exhibited

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she shall be Thruunto Required by the Court and
the same Goods Chattels and Credits and all other the Goods
Chattels and Credits of the said Decd at the time of his Death
Which at any time after I shall come to the hands or
Possession of the said Judith Anderson or into the hands
and Possession of any other Person or Persons I shall
do Well and Truly Administer According to Law
and Further do Make a Just and true Account of her
Actings and Doings therein When Thereto Required by
the Court and all the rest and Residue of the
Goods Chattels and Credits Which I shall be found
Remaining upon the said Administrators Account
the same being first Examined and allowed by the
Justices of the Court for the time being I shall

Deliver and pay unto such Person or Persons respectively
as the sd Justice by their Order or Judgment shall
Direct pursuant to the Laws in that Case made
and Provided and it shall hereafter appear that
any Last Will and Testament was made by the said
and the Executor or Executors therein named do exhibit
the same unto this Court (making Request to have
it allowed and Approved Accordingly if the sd Judith
Anderson being Thereto Required doth produce and deliver
up his Letters of Administration Approbation of
such Testament being first had and made in this
Court Then this Obligation to be Void and of
None Effect or Else to Remain in full Force and
Virtue
