my Estate of every kind; I here Give and Bequeath to my two
Daughters Barbara and Anne, after the Death or Marriage of my
Wife, the following Slaves, to wit, Hannah & Cimmera together with
all the Children they have or may have except one which I shall
hereafter particularly Dispose of, to be Equally Divided Between
them and their Heirs forever, But if either of my Daughters
Barbara or Anne should Die before they come to Age or Marry
then my Will & Desire is, the part given her shall be Subject to
my Estate, I here Give and Bequeath to my Guardian Rich^d
Combins one Negro Girl named Daphne, the Daughter of Cu-
-more to him & His forever. And it is my Will & Desire that
if either of my Daughters Barbara or Anne should Marry contrary
to my Wifes Consent the part herein before Bequeathed to her shall
belong to my Estate, and be Subject to the same Disposition with it
I do hereby Order & Direct my Exors hereafter to be named to sell all my
Estate, both real & Personal not before Dispose of as soon as Conve-
nient may be after the Death or Marriage of my Wife, & it is my Will
and Desire that the Money arising from such Sale be Equally
Divided Between my two Daughters Barbara & Anne.
